# **Prof Rolf Behrents**



Dr. Behrents is presently the Emeritus Professor of Orthodontics at Saint Louis University. In 2013, he was appointed to the post of Editor-in-Chief of the American Journal of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics. He received his orthodontic training at Case Western Reserve University in 1975, and his Ph.D. in human growth & development from the University of Michigan in 1984. He has previously served on the faculty at Case Western Reserve University, The University of Tennessee and Baylor College of Dentistry. Dr Behrents has received numerous awards for his research, teaching and service. He has authored and co-authored numerous articles and has lectured widely.

Dr Marchant specialised in Special Needs Dentistry in 2005 and has worked in the Special Needs Unit at the Royal Dental Hospital Melbourne for the past 15 years. She has been a visiting specialist at the Peter McCallum Cancer Centre and a demonstrator for the University of Melbourne.
